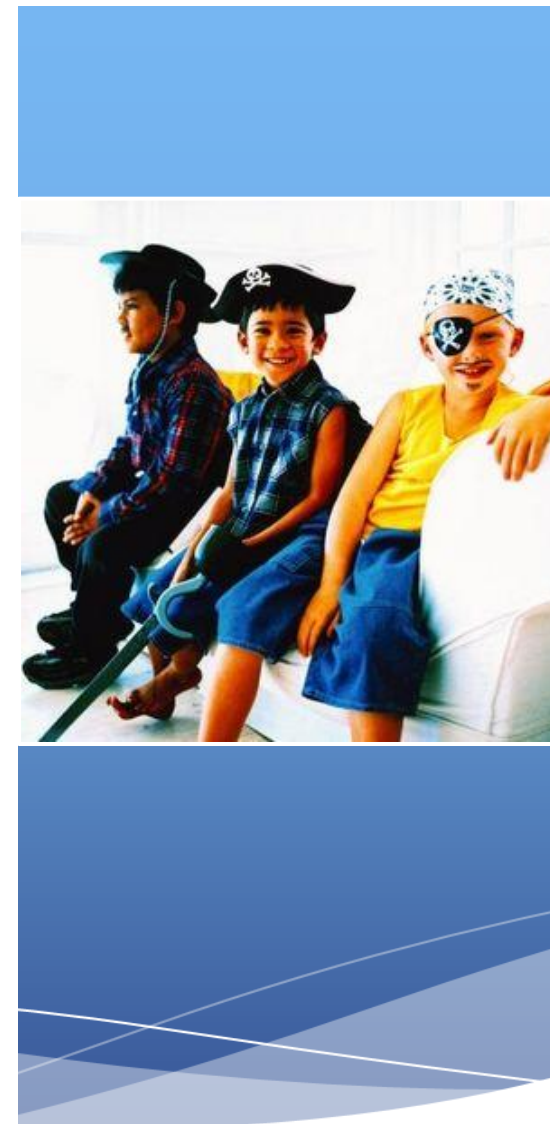

A Social Skills Summer Camp

Always be yourself...

Skills to Succeed knows it's important to teach children the concepts and skills they need to help them broaden their social understanding, especially during breaks from school when a lack of structure and routine can be difficult for children with Autism and related needs. Explore is our pirate-themed social skills camp for grade school aged children that enhances imagination and adventure encourages children to explore the social world while developing communication skills.

Under the guidance and supervision of our trained and experienced staff, our play-based learning environment guides kids through four weeks of adventure which are directed toward supporting, developing, and refining friendship-making skills. Explore provides children with an in-depth understanding of social situations that will help your child increase positive interactions in their relationships with others. Topics to be explored include:

- ★ Making friends
- ★ Helpful ways of being a friend
- ★ Solving social problems
- ★ Responding assertively to bullying

Our program is modified and adapted to the unique needs of each child, ensuring

that all participants have the ability to successfully learn from the experience. A newsletter regarding each adventure is provided to help parents reinforce socially appropriate behaviors and to give kids an opportunity to transfer their learning across contexts.

All participants must be pre-register and pre-pay at least 2 weeks before the program starts and also go through our intake process.
