

INFORMATION ON REPORTING MEDICAID FRAUD AND ABUSE, NEGLECT, & EXPLOITATION

Medicaid fraud is a crime and if it is suspected, it will be reported to the Attorney General's office. The Attorney General's office will investigate and if Medicaid Fraud is proven, Medicaid eligibility could be lost. Other consequences include arrest and prosecution, fines and jail time, civil damages and monetary penalties, exclusion from working in any facility receiving federal health care funds, and loss of certification.

EXAMPLES OF MEDICAID FRAUD:

1. Submitting or calling in time when not working
2. Submitting or calling in time using someone else's name or ID number
3. Performing tasks and/or submitting activity codes notes on the authorized Plan of Care
4. Not performing tasks that are on the assigned Plan of Care
5. Knowingly submitting false information, such as, employment documents
